The International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (CP) is a dynamic, experientially focused two-year programme designed around students' individual career interests. It combines academic study with practical, real-world learning.



Career-Focused Learning

The CP allows students to follow their passions while gaining valuable knowledge and hands-on experience in their chosen career pathways.

Academic & University Pathways

Students build a strong academic foundation by studying:

- 2 IBDP subjects (Standard Level)
- 2 dual-enrolment courses in collaboration with Arizona State University

This combination provides both international academic recognition and university-level experience.



Real-World Experience

A key feature of the CP is career placement, where students:

- Visit local companies and organizations
- Interact with professionals in the Baku community
- Gain practical insights into the workplace

CP Core Components
